Since 2000, ATCS has provided inspection services to construction and maintenance projects throughout the Fredericksburg District with annual average inspection needs of 20 staff members.

ATCS has successfully performed as prime consultant on the current \$6 million Fredericksburg District Wide Construction Inspection contract. Under this three-year contract with the Virginia Department of Transportation (VDOT), ATCS, P.L.C., is leading an experienced multidisciplinary team in providing construction management and inspection services for all highway and road new and maintenance construction projects throughout the Fredericksburg District. This project is built around the following five functional areas: (1) Construction Engineering and Inspection for new highway projects; (2) pavement overlay and scheduling; (3) curb and gutter and special projects; (4) bridge inspection; and (5) support services.

During the three plus-year term of the existing Fredericksburg contract, we have supplied the Fredericksburg District as many as 14 well qualified and VDOT certified Construction and Maintenance Inspectors to work under the direction of VDOT personnel as an extension of VDOT staff. We have provided personnel for construction and maintenance project work and several special projects such as emergency repairs on the I-95/Route 17 bridge, re-coating and lead paint removal on additional bridges crossing I-95, claims analysis, and inspection of traffic signal structures.

- Bragg Road Construction Project;
- I-95/Route 627 FHWA funding participation review and final audit;
